### **Green Shutters fonds**

Green Shutters, a renowned tourist home at Mader's Cove, Mahone Bay, was founded by Laura Judith Strum (1878-1959). The building was located on a 60-acre farm that her grandfather, Peter Strum, had acquired in 1812. Originally built as house in 1855, the tourist home was completely renovated in 1932, the year that Strum opened it to the public. Following many years of successful operation by Strum, the management of the guest house was assumed by Hilda Maud (Grimm) Zinck (1906-2003), who ran the business from about 1950 to 1962. In 1959, Zinck self-published a compilation of the inn's famous recipes, *The Green Shutters Cookbook*, a regional culinary classic that has been revised and is still in print today.

Fonds consists of guest registers, a photograph, and promotional material documenting the operation of the tourist home Green Shutters at Mader's Cove, Mahone Bay.
