Mahone Machine Company, Limited fonds

The Mahone Machine Company, Limited, a general repair shop for machinery of all kinds, was founded in Mahone Bay in 1911 by the contractor and machinist Thomas G. Nichol and two partners, Alex E. Ernst and Orren S. Joudrey. Nichol served as the company's first president. Ernst was appointed as the manager. Among the investors in the company was the prominent merchant C.U. Mader, who also served as a director. The company apparently ceased operations in 1915.

Fonds consists of correspondence, registers, ledgers, cash books, and a minute book relating to the operations of the Mahone Machine Company.

The records were acquired in 1986, when the Mahone Bay Founders' Society was permitted to salvage archival material from the attic of the Mader Hardware building on Main Street in Mahone Bay.
