Royal Hotel Fonds

The Royal Hotel was operated by George Alexander Mader who purchased it in 1889. Prior to Mader, the hotel was known as the Victoria Hall and/or Victoria Hotel and is believed to have been built by James Best before 1857. The hotel closed around 1964 and became a nursing home for senior citizens. The building still stands today, as of February 2022, at 640 Main Street.

George Alexander Mader, son of John Adam Mader and Maria Zwicker, was born April 17, 1848 and died 1925 in Mahone Bay. He married Sophia Adelaide Slauenwhite in 1873. Their son, George Alexander Mader (II), born Nov 26, 1894 in Mahone Bay and died 1949 Mahone Bay. He married Mildred Mary Elizabeth Winters in 1925. At the time of his marriage he was a "hotel clerk" and at the time of his death he was a "retired hotel proprietor".

The fonds consists of one register book dated September 26, 1892 to May 3rd 1904 with guests' names. It appears that some visitors signed their own names while others may have been added to the register by staff, as some signatures appear to have similar handwriting. Among visitors from all over, there is a notable signature brought to our attention by the donor: "Hon. Wilfred Laurier" and "Madam Laurier" visiting from Ottawa on October 14, 1896.

Around the border of the pages of the register book there are local business advertisements (the same on each page). A list of advertisers is available on the next page.

The register book was donated to the Museum in 2018 by Jo-Ann Ramsey, who inherited it from her mother, Jean Cary Ramsey. The register book was accessioned 2018.10.1
