Douglas Eric Veinotte, the son of Leander and Gretchen (Albrecht) Veinotte, was born in 1919 at Mahone Bay. During the Second World War, he served as a private with the West Nova Scotia Regiment in Italy and elsewhere. Veinotte later worked with Atlantic Bridge as a plumber and pipefitter. At the time of his death in 2003, he was living in Oakland, Lunenburg County.

The fonds consists of photographic copies of Veinotte's Canadian Army discharge certificate and photos documenting his military service.

The records were found in the Mahone Bay Museum's backlog and were processed in 2024.
